



I want to close by congratulating and thanking everybody involved in compiling this book, for creating a work of art which we can cherish and enjoy for many years to come.



More in the sheep than the golden fleece.







DIE PIONIERS THE PIONEERS

David Engela
(navorser en lanboubeampte/
researcher and agricultural official)



Die Landboubeampte wat van die begin (1937) nou betrokke was by die ontwikkeling van die ras. Hy moes treinry om by die plase te kom en sy werk het gepaard gegaan met groot persoonlike opoffering om die verskillende kruisings te beoordeel.

The agricultural official who was closely involved from the beginning (1937) in the research and development of the Dorper. He traveled by train to the farms and his work was done with great personal sacrifice to keep track of the different breeding programs.

RY Edmeads
(teler/breeder)



Die teler wat die nouste saam met David Engela gewerk het en na Engela se dood, in 1949, is dit Edmeads wat die stigtingsvergadering byeen roep te Grootfontein Landbou Kollege Middelburg Ooskaap waar op die naam "Dorper" besluit word. (Dorset Horn + Persie = Dorper) Op 19 Julie 1950 word die Genootskap gestig en die Dorper gedoopt.

The Breeder who worked in close co-operation with David Engela and who, after Engela's demise in 1949, called the inauguration meeting at Grootfontein College of Agriculture Middelburg Eastern Cape. At this meeting the name "Dorper" was established as well. (Dorset Horn + Persian = Dorper), on the 19th July 1950.



























Gedurende September 2013, het Regina Valle my gekontak om die streekskou in Bragança Paulista, Brasilië, te gaan beoordeel. There were about 450 Dorpers and White Dorpers competing.

AFRICAN FARMERS Workshop and EXPO 2013

The African farmer's expo took place from the 15th to 17th August 2013 and was attended on behalf of the Dorper Sheep Breeders Society by Gideon du Plessis and myself, Justin Pascoe. It was held at the Nasrec Show Grounds in Gauteng.

We represented the Dorper Sheep Breeders Society with the intention of introducing the Dorper Breed to the Emerging and African farmers.

We arrived on the afternoon of the 14th in order to set up our stand and get the livestock settled in. The organisers of the show were very accommodating and provided us with all our requirements which included Kraals, Bedding, water points etc. The hall we used was well equipped and large enough to comfortably house the various livestock on display as well as other exhibitors.

André Nieuwenhuizen and Zahir Hayat joined us on the first day to assist and share their expertise.

Gideon had sheared Dorpers which consisted of 2 rams, 2 ewes and a lamb on display.

I took unsheared Dorper consisting of 2 ram lambs and two ewes. Our intention was to show the difference as last year they thought they were different breeds.

We had a wide variety of visitors who had lots of questions. As with the previous year, we had a few good chuckles at some of the questions which just goes to show the misconception and naivety with regard to the farming industry as well as the prototyping that "all farmers are rich" and "farming is an easy way to make money", "You buy the sheep, they have babies... and you sell them". There needs to be allot more education about planning, budgeting and more importantly economy of scale e.g. You can't buy 5 sheep graze them on 3 hectares and expect to make a profit.

Some of the visitors were even petrified to go near the sheep, as they were convinced they would be attacked.

Over the 3 day period there was lots of interest and we handed out many breeders lists as well as brochures. Most of the visitors were very impressed and showed a lot of enthusiasm in farming with Dorpers.

Despite the fact that the entrance was free this year, there was a definite decline in visitors compared to last year. There could have been several contributing factors such as the long weekend prior to the show, the cold weather or the obvious one being the on-going recession.

The Dorper breed is still growing worldwide proving that the quality of the Dorper is of a high level and will be growing for years to come. Thanks for the opportunity to promote the Dorper breed.


